He was appointed Assistant Deputy Secretary by Arne Duncan, Secretary of Education in July 2009. Jennings is also the founder of the Gay, Lesbian and Straight Education Network (GLSEN), which brings together lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender (LGBT) and straight teachers, parents, students, and community members who work to end anti-LGBT bias in schools. Under his leadership, GLSEN made safe schools into a national issue and GLSEN student chapters and programs like No Name-Calling Week and Day of Silence became commonplace in America's schools.
